PROFILE OF THE COLLEGE:

Annavaram Satyavathi Devi Govt. Degree College for Women (Autonomous), Kakinada was founded by Women's Education Society in the year 1962. It was formally inaugurated on 2nd Oct. 1962 by Dr. Neelam Sanjeeva Reddy, the then Chief Minister of Andhra Pradesh. The College was managed by the Annavaram Devasthanam Trust till 1968 and then was handed over to the Government of Andhra Pradesh. The College has become a full-fledged Government College with effect from 1968. The Motto of the College is "Sthree Vidya Pravardathaam".

The College was bifurcated on 2nd October 1996 becoming a full- fledged Degree College. Over a span of more than 56 years, the College has grown by leaps and bounds from year to year. The strength of the College has a Consistent 1000 above students in all **07 Conventional, 02 Restructured & 01 Vocational** UG courses of B.SC, B.Com and B.A Programmes. This College is the only **college offering B. Sc Home Science Program** in the Government Sector in the entire Zone – II.

The College has two attached hostels providing boarding and accommodation for nearly 300 students coming from distant places. We are proud to say A.S.D. Govt. Degree College for Women (A) is the only Government Degree College for Women having attached hostels in the entire coastal belt of Andhra Pradesh. The College is accredited with B+ grade in 2005 (Cycle-1) and re-accredited with B Grade (Cycle-2) in 2011 by NAAC, Bengaluru. We are going for re-assessment and accreditation in a few weeks.

Recognizing the potential of the College UGC, New Delhi conferred **Autonomous** status to the College initially for 6 years in the Academic Year 2015-16. Since then the College adopted semester system and CBCS pattern. The present batch is the first out going batch in the semester system under autonomy. We have recently conducted our II Governing Body Meeting on 12 March, 2018.

All the faculty are using iAMS app for registering student attendance. At present college has seven Biometric machines to cater to the needs of student attendance. Besides, it's a usual practice every day that class teachers post directly the student attendance hour wise in class.

There are 41 Teaching staff with five Ph.D holders in the college and 18 Non Teaching staff There are seven e- class rooms fitted with LCD projectors besides 02 Virtual Classroom, 07 Classrooms with LCD Projectors,

Rs. 2 Crores were sanctioned by RUSA which are being used for development of infrastructural facilities of the College. I am happy to say that these funds are utilized for installation of solar panels, establishment of 03 digital classrooms and the biometric attendance devices. The Civil works are to commence shortly by R&B Department.
