

#### ABOUT THE COLLEGE

Annavaram Satyavathi Devi Government Degree College for Women (Autonomous), situated at Jagannaickpur, Kakinada, East Godavari District of Andhra Pradesh. The Institution was established in 1962 through the relentless efforts of "Women's Education Society of Kakinada" with the noble objective of imparting higher education to women in the scenario where there was no separate Degree college for women in the entire district. The College logo represents "Sthree Vidya Pravardhatam", which means, 'Women Education Shall Prosper'.

Initially, the College began with conventional UG Programmes like B.A., and B.Sc. Subsequently, B.Sc. – Home Science in 1963 B.Com. in 1991, B.Sc. – Microbiology in 1998 and B.Sc. Aqua Tech. in 2018 were introduced. Gradually Vocational Courses in B.A. and B.Com. were also introduced. Two P.G. courses viz. M.Com. and M.A.(Telugu) were sanctioned in 2015-16 and 2016-17 respectively. The strength of the college is about 1100.

A good number of Students of this college got employment in Government and non-Government sectors. This is the only Government Degree College for Women in the entire coastal belt with a Social Welfare Hostel and a Student Managed Hostel within the campus and Welfare hostels for girl students within a vicinity of 2 Kms of the college. Due to the dedication, commitment and co-operation of staff and students, the College is conferred Autonomy status w.e.f 2015-16.

The college facilitates Smart Campus with free Wifi, three Virtual Classrooms and three Digital Class rooms with Learning Management Systems. ICT based teaching is made an integral part of the curriculum to enhance the knowledge and skills of the students on par with the global standards.
