3.3.1: ECOSYSTEM FOR INNOVATIONS AND CREATION AND TRANSFER OF KNOWLEDGE

A.S.D. Government Degree College for Women (A) has an eco-system in terms of collaborative arrangements involving technology among all its units, from academic to administration. The institution instils, promotes and inculcates the spirit of innovation and unquenchable thirst for knowledge in the young minds through academic, research and extension activities. The main objective of the Eco-System for innovation is to promote creativity and innovation among students, Faculty members and facilitate development of innovative systems, processes, products, technologies and services for the benefit of the society. The institutional focus is on the promotion of higher education to the Women, empowering them to be an individual with earning potential leading to healthy and productive lives. The activities pertaining to the creation and transfer of knowledge are monitored by Institution's Innovation Centre. The students utilize the creative knowledge of the faculty and become experts in learning at least one craft from Institution's Innovation Centre (IIC). For example, Yuva Crafts and Kitchen Gardening by the department of HomeScience, Grafting and Planting Techniques by the Department of Botany, Commerce and Consumer Club by the department of Commerce are few to highlight.

Objectives Of IIC

The Institution Innovation Council was started in the Institute by the initiative of the Innovation Cell of the Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India. The Council includes members from students and teachers community. A number of activities are conducted through this Council to motivate and promote creativity and innovation among students and faculty members as given below.

- Webinars by Industry Leaders
- Workshops on IPR and entrepreneurship and innovation
- Innovation challenge and business plan competition
- Field visit to incubation centre

The Council constantly offers several technical programs like awareness camps, technology based entrepreneurship programs, and faculty development programs to promote knowledge based innovative ventures.

The following are the activities carried out by Institution's Innovation & Incubation Centre (IIIC).

- 1. <u>YUVA CRAFTS</u> One of the programs offered by IIIC, where, students have been trained to design eco-friendly crafts with a motto "Earn while you Learn" and the products designed were exhibited at "WOMEN ENTREPRENUER TRADE" Many products were exhibited like Jewel making, for example bangles, chains, ear rings, necklaces, bracelets, etc, Apart from this, the students also made rakhis, flower crafts, pottery, wood work. The detailed report is enclosed.
- 2. <u>KITCHEN GARDENING</u> The students are taught the techniques of kitchen gardening by IIC and also experimented in the college campus, By implementing the learned Kitchen gardening techniques, students were able to cultivate organic vegetables and were sold at the campus itself.
- 3. <u>COMMERCE & CONSUMER CLUB</u> The IIIC organizes a seminar or a guest lecture every year on Consumer Awareness, in order to encourage the students who want to market their own ideas or skills and become successful entrepreneurs. Knowing Consumer rights and duties, so that they produce goods keeping in mind the requirements of consumers and satisfy the consumer and does not involve in the unfair practices such as supply of substandard quality, adulteration etc. The detailed report is enclosed
- **4.** <u>GRAFTING AND PLANTING</u> The IIIC also offers a program to the students on Grafting Techniques, where the student will learn about different types of grafting techniques like bark grafting, slice grafting, etc along with terrace gardening tips. Total of four types of plants like money plants, snake plant, Daniela grass, dracaena

colorama, Helconia Citacora etc were sold at "WOMEN ENTREPRENUER TRADE"

- 5. <u>BEST OF WASTE:</u> The IIIC encourages the students to prepare the exhibits, from the discarded waste materials, in order to enable the students to understand the importance of preserving the environment and learn practically about sustainability. The plastics or the waste materials that are condemned are reused to grow plants, to make idols etc. The details are attached in a file.
- **6.** <u>SAMANA:</u> The IIIC organizes SAMANA every year in order to cater the needs of the students who majority of them hail from remote villages in and around Kakinada. In view of exposing the inherent talents of the students, commerce fair is organized every year in the name of SAMANA. It creates awareness on business ideas, starts of small scale industry, improves marketing skills, generates income by selling goods etc. The whole activity for the year 2021 is attached in a file.
- 7. <u>COMMUNITY SERVICE PROJECT:</u> In addition to the above activities the students are encouraged to do community service, where they can acquire knowledge, life skills and provide service to people. It is a wonderful opportunity for students to become active members in their community and create a positive societal impact. For the academic year 2021-22, the II B.Sc students conducted a socio-economic survey in their native places and also gave awareness on various issues like, Environmental Education, Health & Hygiene, Nutrition and Women Empowerment etc. The details of this project are provided in the link of the college website.
