




National Communal Harmony Week.





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
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Campus Cleanliness Drive

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


International Women's Day





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
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World water Day



2. Inauguration:









5. RALLY ON SAVE SOIL:


6. PLANTATION PROGRAMME:

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
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7. RALLY ON PLASTIC USAGE:








10. BLOOD GROUPING:








11.SELF DEFENCE AWARENESS PROGRAMME FOR GIRL STUDENTS:








12. DENTAL CHECKUP:






15. Valedictory Programme:

The campaign helps people to know about the disease, its symptoms, prevention methods and treatment available for the people living with HIV/AIDS. Outcome of the programme is that it's a collective responsibility towards increasing awareness on HIV/AIDS prevention. The people were made aware and educated to handle the situation if someone in the family suffers from the disease.

Awareness Programme on HIV/AIDS:

AIDS or Acquired Immunodeficiency Syndrome is a complex illness with a wide range of complications and symptoms. AIDS is the final stage of HIV. When individuals reach this stage, they are at high risk for opportunistic infections due to their badly damaged immune system.

Outcome of the programme: Students may know the tests available are Enzyme immunoassay (EIA) tests use blood, oral fluid, or urine to detect HIV antibodies Rapid HIV antibody tests All individuals should get tested for HIV at least once a year.

Awareness Programme on HIV/AIDS & Life skills:

Positive speaker provided the information on National Toll Free AIDS Helpline '1097' to answer queries related to HIV/AIDS from anywhere, anytime.

Help line seek counselling, get information on Integrated Counselling and Testing Centres (ICTC), Anti-Retroviral Therapy Treatment Centres (ARTCs) and other service delivery centres. Besides, as and when required, the information will also be sent as a text message to the caller's mobile phone.

Outcome of the programme: Members from Red Ribbon Clubs spread the messages on "Getting to Zero, Zero new infections and AIDS related death". Emphasis was given on "Zero Discrimination". Students may know and spread the significance of National Toll Free AIDS Helpline '1097'.


